- ⑥ More than 80% of paper "data Analysis" is complete in 5th semester B.A (P).
- ⑦ More than 80% of syllabus is complete for G.E. paper ~~G.E.~~ "Introductory microeconomics".
- ⑧ More than 80% of syllabus is complete for paper "BDPI-I" in semester 8th of B.A (P).
