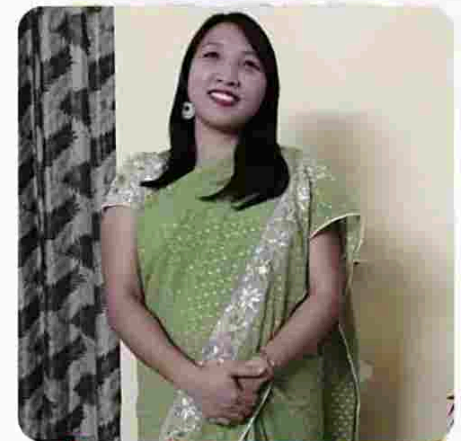
MESSAGE FROM FACULTY COORDINATOR

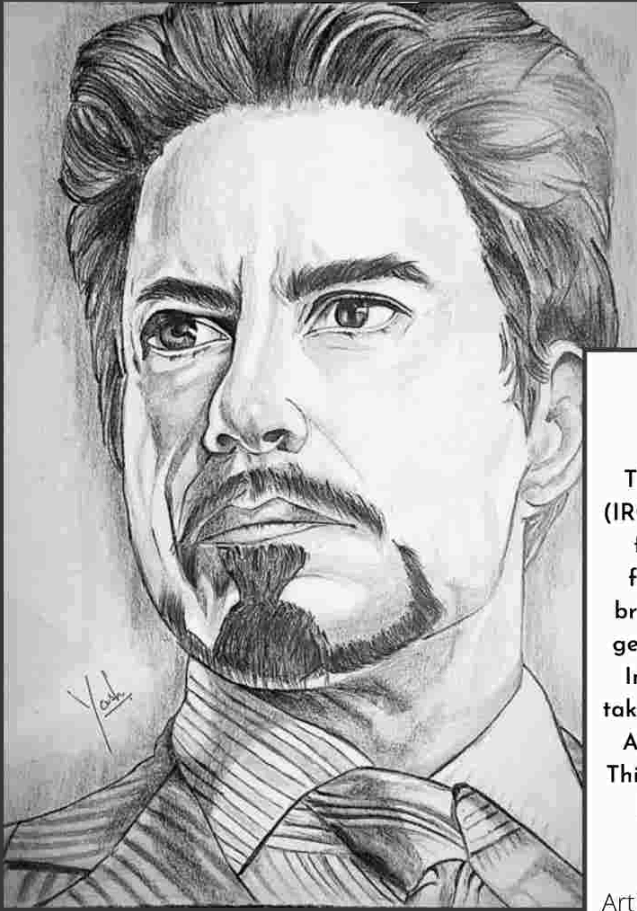

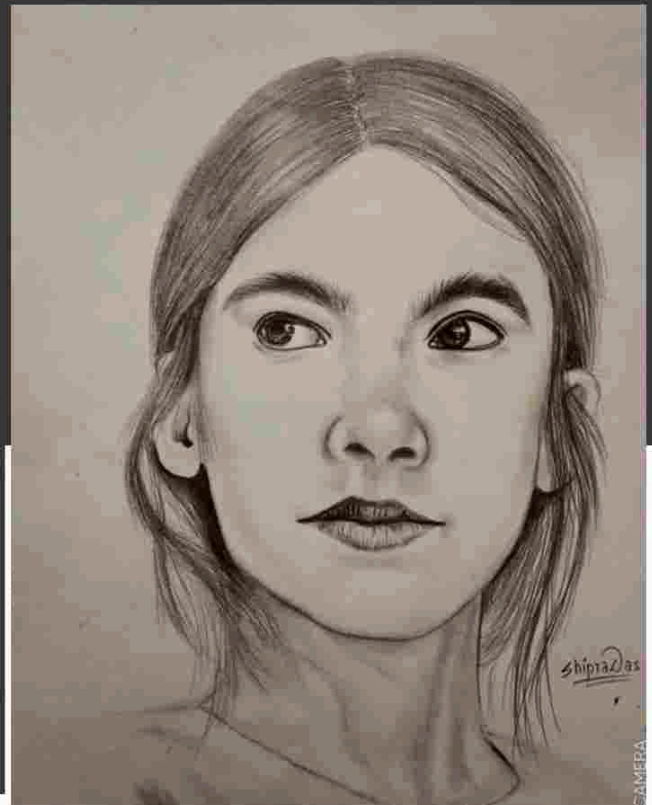
Tony Stark

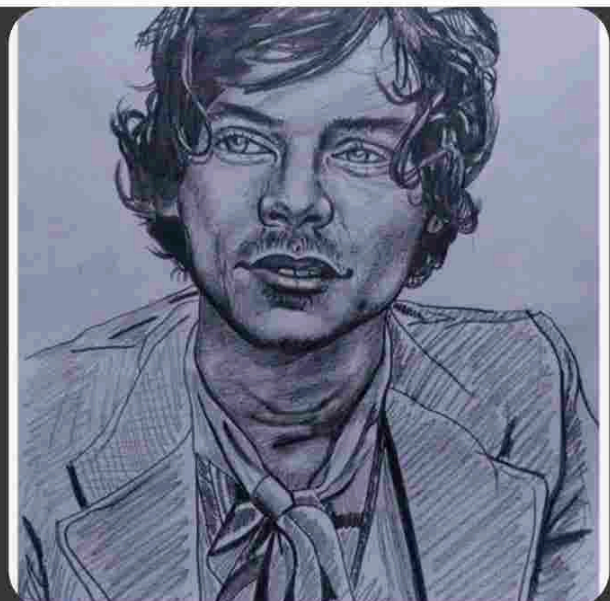
Dr. Strange serves as the Sorcerer Supreme, the primary protector of earth against magical and mystical threats.

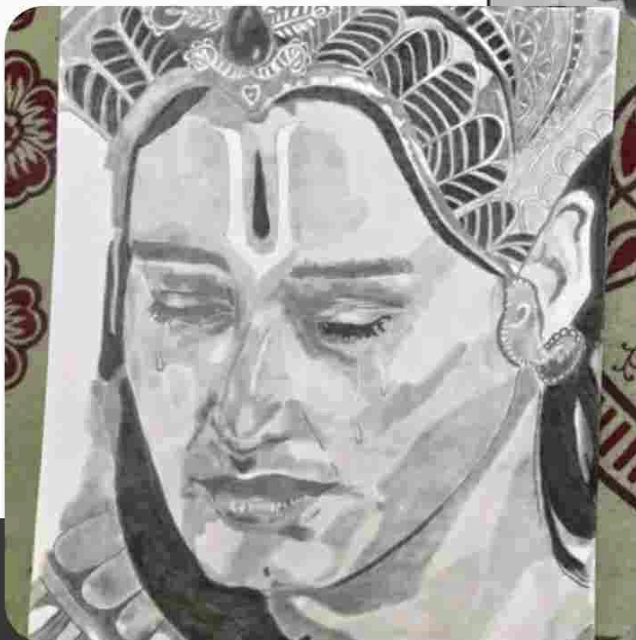

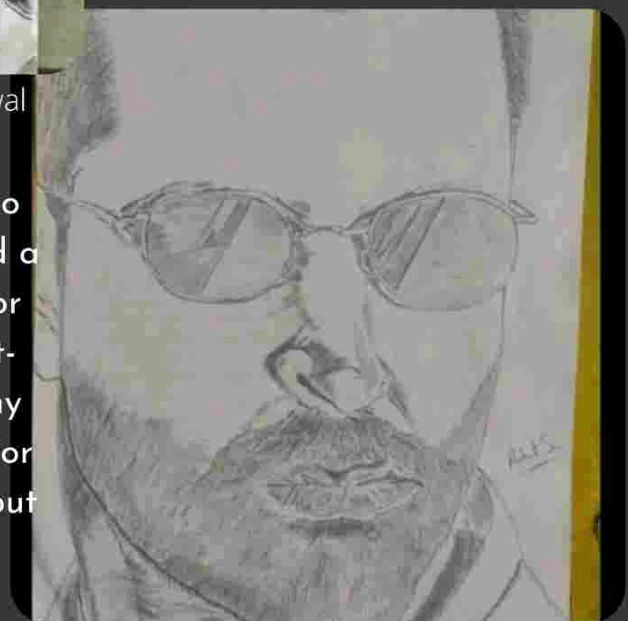

His experiences as a Jujutsu sorcerer bred a deep hatred for non-sorcerers, leading to an incident where Suguru massacred over a hundred civilians in a single night. He was expelled from Jujutsu High and came to be known as the worst of all curse users.
